Constituent/legislator visits are an opportunity for the citizen lobbyist to share concerns and advocate for solutions on issues they care about. It is also an opportunity to educate elected officials in areas of public policy that might be outside their areas of expertise and/or generate more support from legislators who are "with us" on our issue. Please use this worksheet as a guide for conducting the constituent/legislator visit and as a written record of the visit.

<b>Roles:</b> Assign roles participants. Constituents may need to take more than one role. Assure the notetaker records the visit. The facilitator monitors time - assure all issues are covered.	
Leader briefs on organizations and goals, facilitates introductions – including legislator. "HCA-MN and PNHP-MN are non-profit advocacy organizations whose mission is affordable, com-prehensive, high-quality health care for all Minnesotans. We are building a coalition of like-minded individuals and organizations to push for legislation that meets this goal." Have constituents intro-duce themselves. Give legislators time to introduce themselves and make remarks.
